



We've recently been made aware of a few new scams impacting our members. We're sharing this information so you can take necessary precautions.

- 1. Phone Scam:** If you receive a call from someone claiming to work for a consumer lending company and they ask for your personal financial information, please end the call immediately.
- 2. Check Scam:** Individuals are receiving fraudulent checks in the mail. If you receive an "official" check and are not expecting it, the check is most likely fraudulent.

As a reminder, if you are solicited by phone, email, or in person, do not offer the following information:

- Online Banking Credentials
- Debit/Credit Card Number
- CVV Code
- Expiration Date
- Social Security Number
- Birth Date
